The Catalogue is a meta-search engine that searches the full collection of the Leiden University and the LUMC <http://www.library.leiden.edu/catalogues-databases/about-our-systems/catalogue.html%20-%20what-is-being-searched>

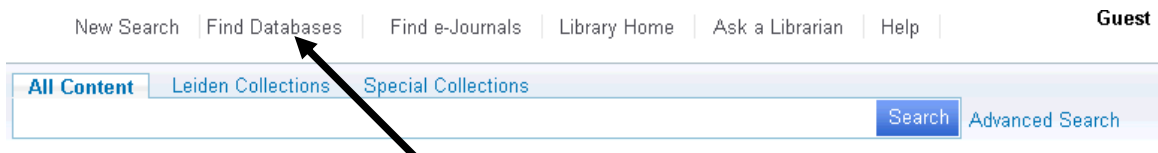
This manual describes how to get full text articles logging into a database. Another manual describes searching for books.

1. Login to a database

- a. Go to www.lumc.nl/org/walaeus and select from the menu at the left side *Databanken*.
 - Select the preferred databaseThe most frequently used databases have a special link for remote access: *Thuisoegang*.
 - select the link for *Thuisoegang*
 - Log in with your ULCN account.
 - The database is now available. For access to the full text with the "Get it @ Leiden" button, sometimes a new login is required. More information under 2.

When no *Thuisoegang* link is offered, open the database via the Leiden Catalogue.

- b. Go to www.lumc.nl/org/walaeus and select *Catalogus*.
 - Select *Find Databases*



Two options to find a database are:

- b1 enter the name of the database in the *Title* search box and click *Search*
- b2 Select the required domain (example: *Medical Sciences*) from the pull down menu at *Subject* and click *Search*
- Select the required database from the list

2. Finding full text of references using "Get it @ Leiden"



"Get it @ Leiden" button is present at all databases of the LUMC and the Universiteit Leiden. This button provides information about full text availability of a reference.

If the "Get it @ Leiden" button is not present in the Abstract View in PubMed, switch to the enriched "Leiden Pubmed" version as described under 1 or use lumc.nl/pubmed. Your search history is retained.

When full text is available, click the presented host name to get access .

In most cases, the "Get it @ Leiden" screen will state that full text is available. By clicking GO, you are linked to the publisher's website.
