



In view of the **vulnerability** of the children in this unit, we would like to draw your attention to the following information.



HYGIENE

- Upon entering the unit and the room, please disinfect your hands using hand sanitizer.
- Avoid wearing rings or other jewellery on your hands.
- Coats should be left outside the room, store these in the locker labelled with the same number as the room that you are visiting
- Smartphones and/or tablets are permitted; upon entering the room please clean these using the available microfiber towel.
- Parents or other visitors suffering from colds, fevers or other illness are asked to please report to the nursing staff prior to entering the room



VISITING THE INTENSIVE CARE

- A maximum of 4 people per room is permitted; this is including the parent(s).
- The parent room is intended for parents and their children, other visitors will be asked to sit on the seats available in the elevator area.
- With the exception of siblings, children under the age of 12 years are not allowed in the unit. They can wait in the seats available in the elevator area and should be accompanied by an adult.
- The use of mobile phones is permitted only in the elevator area.



CHICKENPOX

- Children and adults who have not yet had chickenpox may not enter the unit. They may wait in the elevator area, not in the family room. Children left to wait in the area should be accompanied by an adult.
